

Dear Friends and Family,

I hope this letter finds you well. Although we sent you an update letter a little while back, now the time has come to share with you the phenomenal opportunity that has been given to us. For those of you who did not receive our last newsletter, let me take a few moments to explain this endeavor.

Tywonn and I were given the chance to travel to Nairobi, Kenya, Africa in May, after I attended a missions conference in November. This trip will be to a counseling center, Tumaini (pronounced Too-my-ee-nee) Counseling Center, and a boarding school, Rift Valley Academy (RVA). (RVA has a website, should you want to google it.) Those missionaries placed in Africa or in the surrounding areas experience various life problems that could be easily handled if they were in the United States or Europe. However, since they are in such remote areas these amenities are not available to them. Many of these life problems need to be solved through counseling. Trained counselors located in these two sites are available to provide free counseling in areas such as stress, depression, trauma, marriage, and adjustment. Tumaini has given Tywonn and me the blessing to travel to Kenya to see how we might fit into their center, with me offering counseling there and at RVA. We will be in Kenya for two weeks leaving May 5th and returning on May 19th.

There are many ways that you can partner with us on this journey, because we believe it is not a coincidence that you are reading this letter. We would ask first and foremost that you keep Tywonn and me in your prayers, for it is God who is the leader and director of our lives. Secondly, we are going to Africa on faith that our trip will be financially funded by those who are called to do so. We need to raise \$4500 for our trip. Should you prayerfully decide that you would like to support us financially for this trip, here is how to do so. Race City Church, a partner in missions to Africa, will oversee the distribution of funds. All funds received for missions to Africa will be tax deductible. Please make your checks payable to RACE CITY CHURCH. In the subject line, please put AFRICA MISSIONS. Please mail all money to us at our home address, and then we will mail it to the church to make it easier on the church. The final way you have the opportunity to help us is to tell others about our heart for missionaries and the people of Africa.
